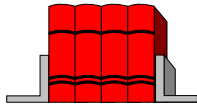

1. Educational Alternatives for Everyone (240 pages) Presents the rationale for choices and options for everyone in education and for new learning systems. Provides the history, research, methods, descriptions, outcomes, assessments on alternatives and cites over 1100 resource references.

2. Creating Educational Futures (320 pages) Describes in detail the why, what, how, and assessments of the program at the Wilson Campus School in Minnesota, *considered the most experimental, comprehensive public school alternatives model in America.*

## ABOUT THE AUTHORS



Don Glines Ph.D. was cited in the *Kappan* as a Vice-President for Heresy. While director of the PreK-12 Wilson Campus School and the

Minnesota State University (Mankato) experimental teacher education undergraduate and graduate programs, *The National Observer* called him “the foremost apostle of educational innovation,” and Wilson was labeled “probably the most innovative school in America.” A first recipient of the Four Seasons Hall of Fame Award for his work with continuous learning, he directed the California State Year-Round Education Program and now is Director, Educational Futures Projects, Sacramento CA.

His previous books include *Creating Humane Schools, Implementing Different and Better Schools, A Primer on Year-Round Education*, and a five-volume *Educational Futures* series.

**William Wirt**, co-author of *The Great Lockout*, (now deceased), was creator of the Platoon System in Gary Indiana, where from 1907 to 1937 he was one of the most innovative and controversial superintendents in the nation.

**Dr. David Mussatti**, co-author of *YRE: Paths to Resources*, (now retired), was a middle school principal, college professor, and year-round consultant who specialized in analyzing available YRE research.

**James Bingle**, co-author of *NAYRE: Historical Perspective*, (now retired), was a chemist, township assessor, and President of the Valley View Illinois School Board during the era when the district was a model K-12 YRE district.
